EMIRATI CHILDREN'S DAY



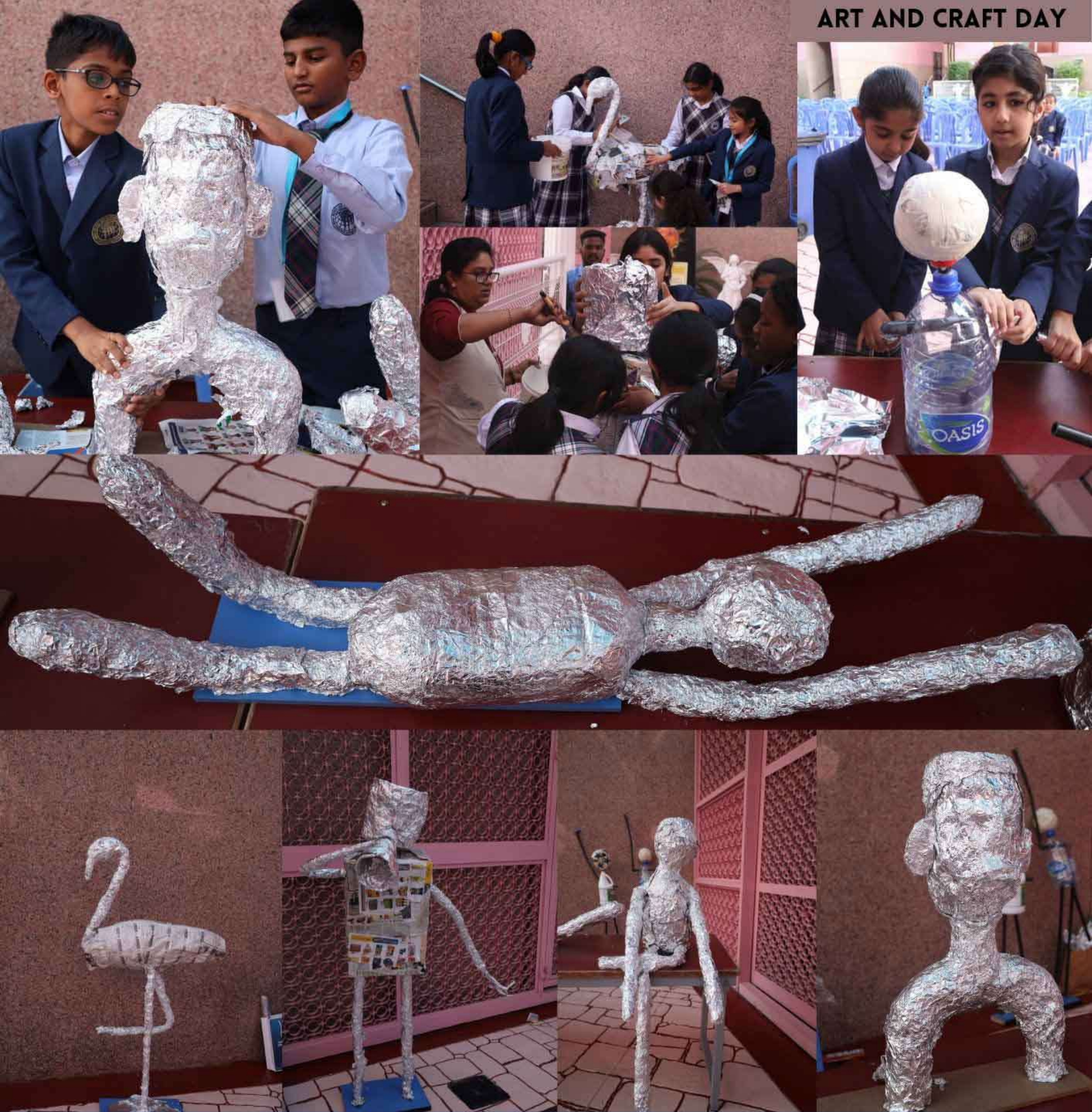
